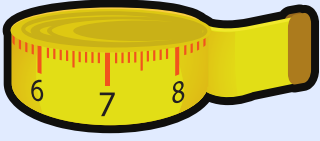

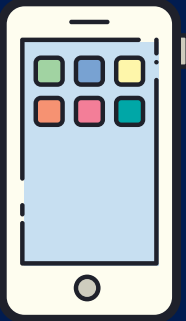
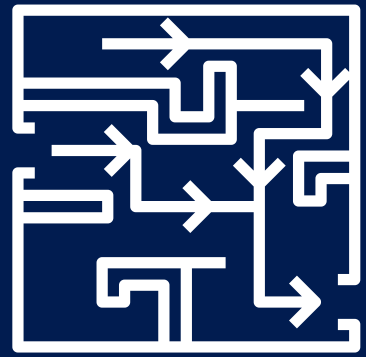


## EMERGENCY WATER SUPPLY

Have at least one gallon or a 24 pack of water for each person per day in your organization. 56% of Americans report that they have enough water on hand for 72 hours.

## PRACTICE EVACUATIONS

Only 36% of organizations surveyed reported that they practice evacuations.

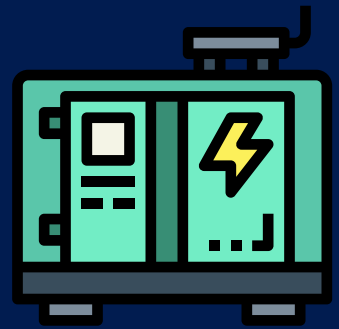


## COMMUNICATION PLAN

Communication is the single most reported failure point in all disasters and emergencies. Only 26% of American organizations reported that they have a communications plan.

## BACKUP POWER/GENERATOR

18% of organizations reported that they have backup power for their facilities.



## EMERGENCY LOCATIONS

Organizations should have emergency locations to keep people safe and continue to provide services. 36% of survey respondents reported that they do.

## EVACUATION KITS

Many types of kits meet individual and organizational needs. Do you have grab-and-go kits for your team? 52% of those surveyed say that they do!
